NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Benton County, Tennessee, that amounts set out in the 2020-2021 Appropriations Resolution are hereby continued until adoption and state approval is received on the FY 2021-2022 Budget Document; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive/Mayor and the County Clerk are hereby authorized to borrow money on tax anticipation notes, not exceeding 60% of the appropriations of each individual fund of the continuing budget, to pay for the expenses herein authorized until the taxes have been collected. The State Director of Local Finance shall first approve such notes. The notes evidencing the loans authorized under this section shall be issued under the authority of Title 9, Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated. All of said notes shall mature and be paid in full without renewal not later than June 30, 2022.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall take effect from and after its passage and its provisions shall be in force from and after July 19, 2021.
