



# **COMMISSIONERS FORUM**

Commissioner Hill announced a budget meeting will be held on June 25, 2019 at 5:00 pm. She encourages all commissioners and citizens to attend. County Attorney discussed the Sheriff's contract, Work Release Programs for Benton County and advised to have an executive session next month.

Sheriff Kenny Christopher spoke about the number of officers and why he needs more. He also stated that raises are needed to keep from losing employees due to low pay.

Mayor Lashlee wanted to thank David Johnson and Mark Florence for being there and their outstanding efforts. He also talked about taxes and the options for our county. He applauded the budget committee for their hard work and diligence to get an accurate budget. He stated we do have a salary problem in the county.
