APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA

Motion was made by Commissioner Patton and seconded by Commissioner Nunnery to approve the Agenda. On a roll call vote, all present voted aye. Motion Carries.

Commissioner Mary Powers has moved from the 6th district and has announced her resignation effective May 31, 2021. She will be a non-participating member tonight.

Due to Commissioner Powers resignation, we will have a 17-member majority tonight.

CITIZENS FORUM

Terry Leonard is representing the Sharing and Caring Community concerning a resolution that passed on February 17, 2004 passed a Resolution for a 99-year lease for the Sharing and Caring committee. Mr. Leonard expressed the communities desire to be left alone by Government.

Mayor Lashlee responding by saying he knew nothing about any harassment and that he could help the community with grants to enhance the area.

Stephanie Harcleroad and Michelle Smith introduced Taso Arima- managing director of Hyperion Metals – to the commission. He wanted to answer any questions about this new business on Main St in Camden. The company is drilling minerals in Benton, Henry and Carroll counties. Both Ms. Harcleroad and Michelle Smith work in that office.

Lisa Wiggington – TEC – and James Garner – TEC spoke about the new fiber broadband coming to Benton County. State Grants were used to provide service to 300 locations in 2020. In 2021, construction is scheduled for 3rd quarter this year for over 87 miles and 1200 locations. The total investment in Benton County is over 8.25 million dollars. They are asking Benton County to earmark funds from monies granted from pandemic funds for broadband infrastructure. They have put in free public hotspot access at several fire departments.

Mark Florence – Director of Schools – spoke about Emergency School Relief funds and how the money was spent and how future funds will used. Technology, infrastructure and teaching staff were among some of the highlights.

COMMISSIONERS FORUM

Commissioner Presson spoke about the contract with Waste Management and possible charges to residents to dump there. He also spoke about sales tax collection in Benton County.

<u>COUNTY MAYOR, ATTORNEY, FINANCE ADVISOR, INVITED GUEST SPEAKER</u> FORUM, OR PROCLAMATIONS

Mayor Lashlee addressed Commissioner Presson's concerns about Waste Management charging residents for dumping there. Mayor said it's in our best interest to have a contract with them.

Sales tax collection is important to the county. Sales tax is high and is prosperous for Benton County.

Mayor Lashlee thanked the Budget Committee for their hard work. He commended Commissioner Phil Melton and said he deserves a pat on the back. He has taken on the Budget Chairman position and has done a great job.

Mayor Lashlee said our county was ranked 94 out of 95 worst broad band counties in the state of Tennessee. That allowed us leverage for grant applications. Since July 2020, Benton County has been awarded 18 million dollars in broad band grants. TEC has been aggressive and has grabbed up a lot of the grant money and is moving broad band forward in the county.

Hyperion Metals is a new mineral mining company in Benton County. We should welcome them in the community.


