Jimmy Kenniston, Vice President of Minor League Football, ask about the status of the ball park fields.


Sheriff Kenny Christopher and Justin Whipple, E911, talked about the radio communication towers.

Meetings of the Redistricting Committee shall be subject to the open meetings provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 8, Chapter 44 and all records of the Redistricting Committee shall be subject to the open records provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 10, Chapter 7. The secretary of the Redistricting Committee shall prepare the minutes of each meeting.

SECTION 5. The Redistricting Committee shall meet from time to time as necessary in order to prepare suggested redistricting plans. The chair of the Redistricting Committee shall report to the Benton County Legislative Body at each regular meeting of the Benton County Legislative Body on the status of suggested redistricting plans.

SECTION 6. The Redistricting Committee shall submit its final suggested redistricting plans to the Benton County Legislative Body by no later than the 15th day of November, 2021.

SECTION 7. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, the public welfare requiring it.


