	Tennessee has remained in the top ten for domestic homicide since 2001.
WHEREAS,	Tennessee reported 90 victims murdered by an intimate partner in 2020;
WHEREAS,	69,385 incidents of domestic violence were reported in Tennessee and 57.7% of domestic violence cases were cleared by arrest or by exceptional means in 2020;
WHEREAS,	Females accounted for 49,636 or 71.5% of all domestic violence victims and males accounted for 19,689 or 28.4% of all domestic violence victims;
WHEREAS,	Children accounted for 6,755 or 9,7% of domestic violence victims in Tennessee in 2020 and the Sycamore Institute indicated that domestic violence was among the top five adverse childhood experiences for Tennessee's children;
WHEREAS,	Abuse of a family member can have a long-term damaging impact on survivors and their children that impacts family, friends, and the community-at-large;
WHEREAS,	Families are indispensable to a stable society and should be a place of support to instill responsibility and values in the next generation;
WHEREAS,	Domestic violence is widespread and is devastating to society as a whole, but particularly to women and children;
WHEREAS,	Violence against women and children is a prevalent social ill due to the historical imbalance of power in gender and age;
WHEREAS,	The problem of domestic violence is not confined to any group or groups of people but crosses all economic, racial, gender, educational, religious, and societal barriers and is sustained by societal indifference;
WHEREAS,	The survivors of domestic violence should have help to find the compassion, comfort, and healing they need, and domestic abusers should be held fully accountable for their crimes against persons and the community; and
WHEREAS,	Our community has a civic and moral obligation to work to prevent domestic violence, to address its brutal and destructive effects, and to make ending domestic violence a community priority.

We have entered into a joint venture with the Industrial Board to hire an economic director. The Industrial Board will be paying half of the salary.



RESOLUTION NO. 20211018-01 SPONSORED BY THE BENTON COUNTY INTERIM MAYOR, RANDY SHANNON LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE: NONE TO ADOPT A REDISTRICTING PLAN FOR BENTON COUNTY

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 5-1-111, requires that, at least every ten (10) years, county legislative bodies shall meet and change the boundaries of county legislative districts or redistrict a county entirely if necessary to apportion the county legislative body so that the members represent substantially equal populations; and

WHEREAS, consistent with the provisions of *Tennessee Code Annotated*, Section 5-1-111, Benton County has prepared a redistricting plan which provides for a county legislative body composed of <u>18</u> members and which creates <u>6</u> districts as depicted on the official redistricting map for Benton County prepared pursuant to *Tennessee Code Annotated*, Section 5-1-110.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Benton County Legislative Body meeting in regular session at Camden, Tennessee, on this 18th day of October, 2021, that:

SECTION 1. There is hereby adopted a redistricting plan for Benton County that provides for $\underline{3}$ commissioners in each of the $\underline{6}$ districts for a total county legislative body of $\underline{18}$ members. The districts for members of the county legislative body are depicted on the official redistricting map for Benton County prepared pursuant to *Tennessee Code Annotated*, Section 5-1-110. A copy of the official redistricting map is attached as $\underline{\text{Exhibit A}}$ to this resolution and is incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. All members of the county legislative body shall be elected at large within the district wherein the candidate seeks election.

SECTION 3. This plan shall take effect upon passage, the public welfare requiring it, provided that vacancies shall be filed in accordance with *Tennessee Code Annotated*, Section 5-1-104.
