After nearly 42 years of marriage, Pete and Sherry now have three wonderful grandchildren: Anson Taylor, Celia Taylor, and Gabe Daniel.

WHEREAS, Sherry has a lifelong membership and passion for her family church, Natchez Trace Baptist Church. Sherry's character and community respect has long been known as someone with a kind and compassionate heart, putting forth her personal efforts in teaching Children's Sunday School, Bible Studies, and daycare to the local community. As much as she has been known as the County Trustee, she will forever be known as someone who always put others first!
